"DON'T SETTLE FOR CHEAP SUBSTITUTES"

Ezekiel 14; Deut. 6:4,5; Matt. 22:37; Mk. 12:28-30

Big Idea: God wants our <u>Love</u>, <u>Devotion</u>, and <u>Trust</u>. He does not want us to settle for <u>idols</u> which are nothing but cheap <u>substitutes</u>.

Ezekiel 14:1-8

- 1. A Condemnation of <u>Idolatry</u> (vs 1-5)
 - 1) There was a problem- they had idols rooted in the heart (3)

Definition of "Idols of the heart" = anything or anyone

that

begins to capture our <u>hearts</u>, <u>minds</u>, and <u>affections</u> more than God.

Idols are anything or anyone more <u>important</u> to you than God.

- 2) Their idols led them into further $\underline{\sin}$. (3)
- 3) Their idols separated them from God. (5)

2. A Call to Repentance (vs. 6-8)

True Biblical Repentance involves:

- 1) Intellect/Mind acknowledge our sin
- 2) Emotions sorrow over our sin
- 3) Will turn away from our sin

Note the example of the Prodigal Son in Luke 15

Key Question: What or who is <u>ruling</u> your heart? God or idols?
